Meeting noted additional Federal funding is available for school toilets and is dependent on being able to access ShakeUp Architecture toilet designs prepared for Croydon Park HS. To date we have not received these designs despite constant requests. This is truly a missed opportunity to fix the largest driver of student dissatisfaction at the school.</li> <li>3. The P&amp;C met with the Member for Drummoyne, Federal Shadow Education Minister, and has been in contact with the Member for Reid's office. Outcomes of these conversations were. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Extremely strong support of the P&amp;C architect commissioned document and designs outlining a vision, plan and materials that can be used right now to upgrade the school</li> <li>o The beauty of the designs is they can be delivered NOW, and as items such as carpet and furniture need updating at the school, they can be updated so they are consistent with the materials provided by the architect.</li> <li>o Everyone has told us to progress, with the architect plans and that we should not wait for School Infrastructure</li> </ul> </li> <li>4. \$150,000 Community Building Partnership grant change <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o We expressed our dissatisfaction with the lack of progress of toilet designs that the \$150,000 is intended to fund, and the Member for Drummoyne agreed</li> <li>o The Member for Drummoyne has submitted a change to the grant for a more 'shovel ready' project which will be to upgrade the Maths</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	Kathryn Zerk, Linda Dunkin, Natasha Mogilin
