Previous motions	Natasha summarised each of the motions that had been passed in previous meetings and why they were raised and carried (below) and then asked Motion 1 To confirm \$70,000 of P&C funds to support motions moved in previous 2022 P&C meetings have been committed • Motion 1 from 22 June 2022 meeting: For CHS P&C to purchase \$30,000 outdoor furniture, which will be matched by a school \$30,000 contribution to be placed and used in the senior courtyard so we can deliver student-inspired designs created by ShakeUp Architecture. • Motion 2 from 22 June 2022 meeting: to spend \$30,000 on furniture in the Maths common to create a purposeful and useful classroom space for students and teachers. • Motion 7 from 22 June 2022 meeting: For CHS P&C to spend up to \$5,000 in consultation with the school on the understanding that the school contributes \$4,100 as the balance to cover the teacher librarian (Jason Munday) library resources funding request. • Motion from 26 July 2022 meeting: To make a \$3000 contribution to year 11 to receive first aid training from Royal Life Saving NSW. By the end of term 3 2022 • Motion from 26 July 2022 meeting: To spend up to \$1000 for a gift for the Year 12 students to support and wish them well in their HSC. • Motion from 26 July 2022 meeting: To spend up to \$1000 for World Teacher Day as a gift for each teacher at Concord HS.
